Has your child or anyone in your household had a fever of 100.0 or higher in the last 24 hours?	Child cleared for entry	<b>STAY HOME:</b> Keep child home until he/she has been fever free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medicine.	<b>STAY HOME</b> Keep child home until all household members have been fever free for 24 hours without fever-reducing medicine.
Has your child received Tylenol, Ibuprofen, or another fever-reducing medication in the last 8 hours?	Child cleared for entry	Note time of administration and reason for administration, then monitor child's temperature every 2 hours throughout the day. - ONLY allowed if for injury	N/A
In the previous 14 days has your child or anyone in your household traveled internationally or on a cruise?	Child cleared for entry	<b>STAY HOME:</b> Keep child home for 14 days after returning home.	<b>STAY HOME:</b> Keep child home for 14 days after household members returned home.
In the previous 14 days has your child or anyone in your household had close contact with someone with a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19 or is under investigation for COVID-19?	Child cleared for entry	<b>STAY HOME:</b> Keep child home for 14 days after exposure.	Monitor child's temperature every 2 hours.
Has your child or anyone in your household had any of the following symptoms in the past 3 days: - shortness of breath - difficulty breathing - cough - vomiting or diarrhea - Note time of incident	Child cleared for entry	If all other answers are NO: Monitor child's temperature every 2 hours.  If any other answer was YES: <b>STAY HOME</b> until symptom free for 48 hours	If all other answers are NO: Monitor child's temperature every 2 hours.  If any other answer was YES: <b>STAY HOME</b> until symptom free for 48 hours.

\*\*Close contact is 10 minutes or more within 6 feet of someone
